Equipment List – Items required for camp

Craft Material

Basically, anything that could be used as craft material – any type of junk whatsoever

Cardboard of all sizes – As much as possible. Wire/Bulbs/Batteries/Old electrical equipment – In order to 'construct' a K-9.

Mosaics – Old tiles. 'Grouting'. Tile cutters. See Mr. T. for details. Paints (various colours), paintbrushes. Enough for the cave painting for each cub and for decorating craft material throughout the weekend.

Paper and card – A large amount of all sizes and colours. Both for writing notes on, using as craft material, for use in origami, drawing cartoons on, making planes, gliders, viking/roman equipment. Will be used throughout the weekend.

Scissors, knifes, glue, glue, glue, paper, paper, paper, card, card, card, pencils, pens, rulers, string, plasticine, balloons, straws, paper clips, rubber bands, etc. The usual drawing and craft type tools.

Plastic bottles – The 2-3 litre lemonade type bottles. For use in constructing a space shuttle. Egg Boxes – For use in the space shuttle and other projects.

Cardboard discs – all sizes for the mini-market. Toilet/Kitchen roll tubes. Cloth for making small 'parachutes'. Garden/Bamboo canes/plenty of string/bin liners/paper/card – for making kites. Pens – For Calligraphy. Do we have any pens that would give a nice writing style/stroke?

Matchsticks - For building a scale model of a longboat.

Large plastic/cardboard boats ready made - See Mr. T. for details.

Knitting Material

Wool, Knitting Needles. Enough for each cub to knit their own scarf during the course of the week.

Games Material

The usual selection of footballs, tennis balls, stumps, rounders bats, cricket bats. Wool 'tags' of some description for a variation on run-outs. Some semaphore type flags. A long length of rope or two.

Scouts Own Material (Rosemary)

Service papers. Selection of songs/hymns/prayers for the cubs to base their own on.

Foodstuffs

Foods required for cooking on an open fire. These should include some form of 'sausage meat' so that the cubs can create their own 'dinosaur burgers'.
